there are hours comers with light winds from the S.W.  
saw breacher at 1 came up with them at at sun set and  
they were sperm whales to hunt for to live milk & later part  
light winds and good weather all hands employ Boiling oil

Remarks on board Monday March 7<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with light winds from the S.W.  
saw whales at 11:20 fasten with the boats and a surgeon  
took him a long side milk & later part light winds and  
all hands got breakfast but in the whale finished cutting at 4  
Pm started the works & Co. Lat 00:11 N

Remarks on board Tuesday March 8<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with light winds from the S.W. all hands  
employ & stowing iron oil and boiling stove so that in the room  
milk & later part calm saw grampuses & Co.

Lat 00:20 P

Remarks on board Wednesday March 9<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with calm weather all hands  
employ Boiling oil finished at 60 Pm at day light comers  
storing iron and & Co.

Lat 00:20 N

Remarks on board Thursday March 10<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with calm weather all hands employ  
storing iron oil at 1 Pm saw spie 90 lbs milk part calm  
later part the same with all hands employ storing iron oil

Lat 00:21 N

Remarks on board Friday March 11<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with calm weather all hands employ  
storing iron oil finished at 3 Pm and comers boiling  
out to boiler the oil in the main hatch found a large ball  
leaked with out of it worm hole at 11 Pm took a brace from  
the 6th mile & later part comers with all hands employ  
boiling oil and storing iron

Remarks on board Saturday March 12<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with moderate winds from the 6th  
staying & finished storing iron at 2 Pm washed & Co.  
milk & later part light winds

Lat 1:34 N

Remarks on board Sunday March 13<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with light winds from the 6th  
saw whales at 5 Pm but could not ascertain whether  
they were sperm whales or not milk part light winds  
raise whales at 7 Pm low at 10 and 30 saw the same hours

Remarks on board Monday March 14<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with light winds from 6th all hands  
employ Chopping wharves struck and fire one took him a long  
side & but him in started the works & Co. comers boiling  
body with plenty of wharves in sight to late for to live  
milk part light winds store one half of the tonight each way  
saw whales at day light but all hands low and fire one took  
him a long side got breakfast but in the whale main rail  
and comers clearing it way the heads and so on the same  
hours

Remarks on board Tuesday March 15<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with light winds from the 6th all  
hands employ boiling oil milk & later part light winds  
saw porpoises & Co.

Lat 3:03 N

Remarks on board Wednesday March 16<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with light winds from the 6th all hands  
employ boiling oil but low at 4 Pm for a shower of rain  
finished boiling oil and comers on fat lean milk part sun  
rain later part clearing weather saw porpoises & Co.

Lat 3:24 N

Remarks on board Thursday March 17<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with light winds and blowing  
weather with light squalls of rain saw 1 sail at a distance  
milk & later part boiling winds and plenty of rain  
No observation

Remarks on board Friday March 18<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with blowing winds from all parts  
of the compass milk & later part the same with  
plenty of rain

Remarks on board Saturday March 19<sup>th</sup> 1842

there are hours comers with falling winds from all parts  
of the compass with plenty of rain milk & later part the  
same
