steaming for timber harbor came to anchor at 3 Pm
and in timber harbor in 4 fathoms of water ends with
light nine's men employ'd at ship's duty

Remarks on board Friday May 27 1842
the 24 hours bonusses with midrait trails from the S.W.
men employ'd painting ship sent a boat to shore chopping
wood took the oil from the blanch barrel & Co. and sent it to
goe within

Remarks on board Saturday May 28 1842
the 24 hours bonusses with midrait winds and good
weather all hands employ'd painting ship and chopping
wood broke out and cooked 30 lbs of meat

Remarks on board Sunday May 29 1842
the 24 hours bonusses with midrait winds and good weather
all hands employ'd chopping wood got ready for watering & Co.
at 5 Am sent a raft after water returned at 9
hoisted it in got a boat load of wood & Co.

Remarks on board Monday May 30 1842
the 24 hours bonusses with midrait winds from the
S.W. all hands employ'd getting water wood & Co.

Remarks on board Tuesday May 31 1842
the 24 hours bonusses with midrait winds from
the S.W. all hands employ'd getting wood & water
at 7 Am sent 1 boat crew on 34 hours liberty

Remarks on board Wednesday June 1 1842
the 24 hours midrait with 2 boats crews employ'd
at ship's duty one on liberty

Remarks on board Thursday June 2 1842
the 24 hours bonusses with midrait with one boat crew
returned from town and sent a more on liberty
others employ'd painting ship

Remarks on board Friday June 3 1842
the 24 hours bonusses with midrait with 2 boats crews of my
liberty one on board employ'd at ship's duty

Remarks on board Saturday June 4 1842
the 24 hours bonusses with midrait winds men on board getting
the ship ready for sea at 5 Pm 1 boat returned from the town
2 men short Henry Harbet & Stephen Benson they report
for to burn on board sent 1 boat after iron pole at 4 Am the rest
employ'd bending sails & Co.

Remarks on board Sunday June 5 1842
the 24 hours midrait winds and good weather all hands
employ'd getting ready for sea at 4 Am took our anchor and
proceed to sea in company with 3 other ships

Remarks on board Monday June 6 1842
the 24 hours bonusses with midrait trails from the
Westward hailing 5 M from 5 to 6 distance 5 leagues
tacked ship at 7 and hauled of shore all night tacked ship
at 4 Am and hauled in shore sent the land at 10 Am
men employ'd at ship's duty
Lat 3 - 40 S

Remarks on board Tuesday June 7 1842
the 24 hours bonusses with midrait trails from the
S.E. spoke the ship maintained of S.W. at 5 M
out no oil tacked ship at 1 Pm and hauled W.B.S. double
raft at 12 Am at 9 took in the S.W. at 12 took in main sail
later put strong trails saw fleet of humpbacks &
black fish
Lat 3 - 54 S

Remarks on board Wednesday June 8 1842
the 24 hours bonusses with strong trails from the S.E.
hailing S.W. 6 fathoms ship at 6 Pm and hauled W.B.S. 12 Am
Cape Blanco bearing S.E. distance 12 leagues took in S.W.
Jannet & again sail at 12 Am 3 men below six mile
& later put strong trails split the S.W. on part it and
sent it with one
Lat 4 - 15 Cape Blanco bearing
S.W. distance 5 leagues

the 24 hours bonusses with strong trails from the S. tacked ship
