

Remarks on board Saturday September 7th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with bonusses maidrait from the
S. & sailing to the S. & E. wind all hands employ'd stowing iron
at 5 o'clock the ship Columbus of Nantucket 39 months out
1200 lbs mule & later part maidrait from all hands employ'd
coopering meat getting out shooks & C.

Remarks on board Sunday September 8th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with maidrait from the
S. & sailing off S. W. all hands employ'd stowing it away the
noon from between decks in the fore hold finished at 5
o'clock of 4 C. & mule & later part brisk train's
Sat 2:00 P.M.

Remarks on board Monday September 9th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with brisk train's from the S. & sailing
6:00 mile and later part brisk train's saw hump backs
and one sail at a distance men employ'd setting up shooks
Observation

Remarks on board Tuesday September 10th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with brisk train's from the S. & sailing
6:00 men employ'd setting up shooks made ship at 4 P.M. and
here 11:30 P.M. hatched & gain at 12 P.M. and later 6:00
mile & later part maidrait from all hands employ'd

Remarks on board Wednesday September 11th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with maidrait from the
S. & sailing 6:00 men employ'd setting up shooks finished
at 4 P.M. had set up 14 short back & C. tops in 2
days mile & later part light train's at day light
saw the same distance 4 leagues off of main sail
and stave for bonusses and so ends there are 24 hours

Remarks on board Thursday September 12th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with light train's from the S.
sailing for bonusses at 4 P.M. came to anchor in bonusses
harbour in 34 fms of water all hands employ'd getting
it raft ready at 6 P.M. sent it raft & shooks of 1000 lbs
stave with 1 foot for to fall and went it moving with
2 boats and so ends there are 24 hours

Remarks on board Friday September 13th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with maidrait from the S. & sailing
all hands employ'd getting water & C. took on board 125 lbs
stove it below and sent a boat to wooding and so ends there are
hours

Remarks on board Saturday September 14th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with maidrait from the S. & sailing
with all hands employ'd getting wood & water and so ends
there are hours

Remarks on board Sunday September 15th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with maidrait from the S. & sailing
with all hands employ'd getting wood & water
& C.

Remarks on board Monday September 16th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with maidrait from the S. & sailing
with all hands employ'd getting wood & water
and beating of potatoes & C.

Remarks on board Tuesday September 17th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with maidrait from the S. & sailing
with all hands employ'd getting wood water & C.

Remarks on board Wednesday September 18th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with maidrait from the S. & sailing
all hands employ'd getting wood water and pota
toes and other work

Remarks on board Thursday September 19th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with maidrait from the S. & sailing
with all hands employ'd getting of potatoes and other
work at 1 P.M. all things being ready we took our
anchors and proceeded to sea

Remarks on board Friday September 20th 1842
there are 24 hours bonusses with light train's from the S. & sailing
beating out of bonusses state the shooks & C. and being
the laborers in the shank painter at 6 P.M. bonusses
having 6:00 distance 5 leagues mile & later part maid
train's
Sat 3:30 P.M.
