 The 24 hours compasses with light trails from the S.E.
 Steaming N at 2 Pm finished making the span on
 and put it out hole 56 at dark brought up the jars
 and laid on the wind hiki S.W. nine round at 12 and
 hiki S.E. at day light mail all sail at 10 am saw
 the land Charles's island bearing N.W. distance
 5 leagues

Remarks on board Monday October 3rd 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with light trails from the
 S.E. Steaming N.W. at 6 Pm South the head of Abbenmar
 bearing N distance 6 leagues at 10 Pm brought up the
 jars and laid of shore hooked in shore at 9 Pm
 later part mail trail's sail at 8 distance

Remarks on board Tuesday October 4th 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with mail trail's from the
 S.E. Steaming before the wind of long narrow island
 at 4 Pm sent 1 boat in and speared some fish mail
 & later part strong trail's hiki of shore
 Lat 00 30 S

Remarks on board Wednesday October 5th 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with mail trail's from the S.E.
 hiki W.S.S. mile & later part light trail's sail
 plenty of fishbacks blacked the anchors and then
 none no observation

Remarks on board Thursday October 6th 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with light trails from the
 S.E. bore W.S.W. mile & later part mail trail's
 trail's saw fishbacks & C.
 Lat 1 00 S

Remarks on board Friday October 7th 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with mail trail's from the
 S.E. bore W.S.W. saw plenty of fishbacks mail trail's
 at ship's entry mile & later part mail trail's
 Lat 1 20 S

Remarks on board Saturday October 8th 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with mail trail's from the S.E.
 Steaming off at 1 Pm saw breaches steam for them
 and they proved to be humpbacks mail & later part mail trail's
 Lat 2 12 S

Remarks on board Sunday October 9th 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with mail trail's from the
 S.E. Steaming S.W. B.W. at dark hiki on the wind
 and hiki S.W. mile part light trail's at day light
 hiki of W.S.W. later part light trail's
 Lat 3 01 S

Remarks on board Monday October 10th 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with light trails from the
 S.E. hiki to the S & Westward mile & later part
 mail trail's watch in play at ship's entry
 Lat 3 57 S

Remarks on board Tuesday October 11th 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with mail trail's from the S.E.
 Steaming to the S & Westward the watch in play at
 ship's entry mile & later part mail trail's
 Lat 5 01 S

Remarks on board Wednesday October 12th 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with mail trail's from the S.E.
 Steaming to the S & Westward watch in play at ship's
 entry spoke the ship's rigging lost brook 23 masts
 out 650 lbs mile & later part mail trail's
 Lat 5 37 S

Remarks on board Thursday October 13th 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with mail trail's from the S.E.
 hiki saw fishbacks & by more ship at day light and
 Steamed to the S & Westward mile & later part light trail's
 Lat 5 33 S

Remarks on board Friday October 14th 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with light trail's from the
 S.E. hiki for whales spoke the ship's rigging lost
 brook 23 masts out 650 lbs mile & later part mail trail's
 Lat 6 57 S

Remarks on board Saturday October 15th 1842
 The 24 hours compasses with light trail's from the S.E.
 hiki for whales mile & later part light trail's
 mail trail's at ship's entry
 Lat 4 23 S
