 saw blackfish mile & later part brisk trade the
 watch employed at ships duty

 the as 24 hours commences with moderate trade from the S.E.
 and pleasant weather steaming to the S.E. spoke in
 top galant sails at dark and heard to the south main sail at
 day light and steam S.W. spoke the ship George of Fairhaven
 Capt. Swift 22 masts at 400 saw finbacks & Co.
