 and good weather saw 1 sail at distance took in sail
 at dark and shifted to the N & E wind mile & later part main trade
 trade main sail at day light and stand NW Lat 4 = 42 S

Remarks on board Tuesday December 9 1842
 the as 24 hours bonusses with main trade from the SE and good weather Steaming
 N ramished the west & Co mile & later part main trade
 Lat 4 = 20 S
