

Remarks on board the *Wednesday* December 7th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with moderate winds from the SE
 and good weather steering. I saw Blackfish & porpoises
 the watch employed making squarings and other necessary
 work took in the light sails at dark made fast moderate
 sails at day light main sail and stowed & set of the fore
 gize & Co. Lat 1 = 24.5

Remarks on board Thursday December 8th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with moderate winds from the SE
 bore steering I saw one sail at a distance saw porpoises & Co
 at 1 PM spoke the *Henry Esten* of New Bedford 35 months 100
 lbs mill & later part moderate winds & rain with light
 squalls of rain the watch employed at ship's duty
 Lat 00 = 33.5

Remarks on board Friday December 9th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with moderate winds from the SE
 and good weather and I cruising for wharves saw porpoises
 & Blackfish spoke the ship *Thermy* of New Bedford 35 months 100 lbs mill & later part moderate
 winds Lat 1 = 19.5

Remarks on board Saturday December 10th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with light winds from the SE
 and good weather at 1 PM took in the fore gable sail
 & gale sail mill & later part strong winds saw one
 sail at a distance saw porpoises & Co. Lat 1 = 13.5

Remarks on board Sunday December 11th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with moderate winds from the SE
 and good weather saw porpoises saw one sail at a distance
 mill & later part moderate winds Lat 1 = 01.5

Remarks on board Monday December 12th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with moderate winds from the
 SE and good weather spoke ship *Henry Esten* Capt
 Penhlan 35 months 100 lbs mill & later part moderate
 winds but it was fore sail and reefed up there
 all are Lat 00 = 24.5

Remarks on board Tuesday December 13th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with light winds from the SE
 steering I took in sail at dark made fast fore sails
 later part light wind the fore fore mast stay sail and made it
 and put it & gain Lat 00 = 10.25

Remarks on board Wednesday December 14th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with moderate winds from the SE
 and good weather and I cruising for wharves the watch employed
 at ship's duty at 4 PM about the main sail and bonnet
 merrily & it ends with light winds Lat 1 = 02.5

Remarks on board Thursday December 15th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with light winds from the SE and good
 weather saw Blackfish & porpoises merrily the main sail and
 but it ended later part moderate winds Lat 1 = 32.5

Remarks on board Friday December 16th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with moderate winds from the SE
 and merrily with at day light main sail and stowed
 & Co about the main top sail and mile stowed
 & Co. Lat 2 = 44.5

Remarks on board Saturday December 17th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with moderate winds from the SE
 steering I stowed the main top sail & Co at 1 PM merrily
 it rained that did not act right but after rain it seemed
 to be it spew in whale land but could not forewarn the whale
 was going to fast for us mill & later part moderate winds
 Lat 2 = 56.5

Remarks on board Sunday December 18th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with light winds from the SE
 with smoke with spoke the ship *Colonie* of New Bedford
 Capt 17 months 100 lbs mill & later part strong
 winds saw I Breach but never saw it more saw one sail
 at a distance Lat 2 = 54.5

Remarks on board Monday December 19th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with moderate winds from the SE
 with smoke with saw porpoises the watch employed
 at ship's duty Lat 1 = 52.5

Remarks on board Tuesday December 20th 1842
 There are hours bonanzas with moderate winds from the SE
 and I cruising for wharves mill & later part light winds
 saw Blackfish & porpoises & Co
