

Remarks on board Thursday August 10 1843
 the 24 hours commences with moderate winds from
 the Eastward the watch in employ setting up
 shrouds and mending the foremast's shortens
 sail at 12 Pm took up the main top sail
 and furl the fore sail at daylight both of the
 at 11 left to and took in the main top sail
 mended the main top gale sail and with
 heavy gails from the S
 Sat 29 = 12 N

Remarks on board Friday August 11 1843
 the 24 hours commences with heavy gails from
 the S at 2 Pm took in the foremast and turned
 up the waist boat and mended things snug mill
 part heavy gails and plenty of rain at 4 Pm more
 moderate at 4 set the main top sail and fore sail
 and steared N by with strong winds and light
 squalls of rain Sat 30 = 40 N

Remarks on board Saturday August 12 1843
 the 24 hours commences with strong winds from
 the S W steering N by under short sail mill &
 later part moderate winds from the S W mended
 all sail at daylight and steared S by some passengers
 the watch in employ at ship's duty mended
 new mast boat for the fore mast and portition
 Sat 30 = 41 N

Remarks on board Sunday August 13 1843
 the 24 hours commences with moderate winds from
 the S W steering S by shortens sail at dark and
 steared S mill part plenty of rain later part
 strong winds from the S W with heavy swell
 from the S W saw breaches & finbacks
 Sat 30 = 00 N

Remarks on board Monday August 14 1843
 the 24 hours commences with moderate winds from
 the N and steering S by with fine weather shortens
 sail at dark mill & later part moderate winds and
 fine weather on board the fore top sail and foremast
 mending it Sat 29 = 37 N

Remarks on board Tuesday August 15 1843
 the 24 hours commences with moderate winds from
 the N by steering S at 6 Pm but the fore top sail
 and shortens sail at dark mill & later part moderate
 winds with light squalls of rain unsew one of the cutting
 galls and rose a new one mended & set up lifts & foot
 ropes for the top sail yards & S
 Sat 29 = 12 N

Remarks on board Wednesday August 16 1843
 the 24 hours commences with moderate winds from
 the S at 3 Pm the wind shifted to S shortens sail at
 dark and steared S by mill part plenty of rain
 later part moderate winds mended new runners for the
 fore & main top sail yards
 Sat 29 = 35 N

Remarks on board Thursday August 17 1843
 the 24 hours commences with moderate winds from
 the S S steering S by shortens sail at dark mill
 & later part mill & later part moderate winds and fine
 weather at daylight raised whales board struck and
 parted the line and chased but of no use came on board
 wore ship and hove to the Eastward
 Sat 30 = 00 N Long 164 = 40 f

Remarks on board Friday August 18 1843
 the 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the
 S S steering S by and fine weather the carpenter
 in employ mending the waist boat with which was
 store by having the fall pated and hove out the stow
 part shortens sail at dark mill & later part light
 winds and fine weather the watch in employ at ship's
 duty Sat 30 = 43 N

Remarks on board Saturday August 19 1843
 the 24 hours commences with moderate breezes
 from the S S and fine weather the watch in employ
 at ship's duty shortens sail at dark mill & later part
 light winds and fine weather sent new fore top
 lifts Sat 31 = 24 N

Remarks on board Sunday August 20 1843
 the 24 hours commences with light winds from the S
 mill part the same later part strong winds and light squalls
 of rain Sat 30 = 40 N
