

Remarks on board Tuesday November 7th 1843
these 24 hours commences with light baffling
winds from NW to SE middle part rainey
later part the same with moderate winds
steering NW by N lat 30

Remarks on board Wednesday November 8th 1843
these 24 hours commences with moderate winds
from the S to S.W. and plenty of rain
middle part the same later part moderate winds
and fine weather on board the main top galant sail
and bent & nother one lat 30 - 27 N

Remarks on board Thursday November 9th 1843
these 24 hours commences with moderate winds
and fine weather steering E by N middle & later
part moderate winds and fine weather the watch
employ mending the main top galant sail bent
at 11 1/2 PM lat 30 - 54 N

Remarks on board Friday November 10th 1843
these 24 hours commences with pleasant gails and
fine weather steering E by N the watch employ
at ships duty middle & later part strong breezes
and fine weather lat 31 - 27 N

Remarks on board Saturday November 11th 1843
these 24 hours commences with pleasant gails from
the SE heading E by N the watch employ at ships
duty middle part moderate at 1 PM set the
fore topmast standing sail at a wind hall
sailing round to N with strong gails
bent all hands and double night the top sails
later part more moderate turned out the
reps lat 31 - 20 N

Remarks on board Sunday November 12th 1843
these 24 hours commences with moderate winds
from the NW with a heavy swell middle
& later part gentle breezes lat 30 - 57 N

Remarks on board Monday November 13th 1843
these 24 hours commences with pleasant gails and
fine weather wind NW heading E and E by S
with all sail middle & later part light winds from
the NW the watch employ at ships duty
lat 30 - 10 N

Remarks on board Tuesday November 14th 1843
these 24 hours commences with light winds from the
NW heading E the watch employ at ships duty
middle & later part light airs from the NW
lat 29 - 14 N

Remarks on board Wednesday November 15th 1843
these 24 hours commences with light airs from the
S heading E the watch employ at ships duty
middle & later part calm the watch employ mending
the main top sail lat 29 - 33 N

Remarks on board Thursday November 16th 1843
these 24 hours commences with calm weather
at 4 PM bent the main top sail middle &
later part light airs from the NW at 4 PM
commenced mending the main sail lat

Remarks on board Friday November 17th 1843
these 24 hours commences with light airs from the
NW the watch employ mending the main
sail middle & later part moderate winds from
NW lat 29 - 37 N

Remarks on board Saturday November 18th 1843
these 24 hours commences with moderate winds
from the NW at 6 PM tacked ship and heeled
N by W middle & later part strong winds from
the Eastward No observation

Remarks on board Sunday November 19th 1843
these 24 hours commences with strong winds from the
E heading NW with cloudy weather at 6 PM
bent the top sails middle & later part strong
gails from the Eastward No observation
