these 24 hours commences with strong gails from the
N steering 6 at 1 Pm double reef the fore top
sail took in the jib & spanken middle part
pleasant gail throughout the reefs set jib &
main top galant sail at 9 Am set the fore
& main top galant sails ends with pleasant
gails from the N lat 31-35 N

Remarks on board Tuesday December 2nd 1843
these 24 hours commences with pleasant gails from
the N steering 6 with all sail at 4 Pm
bent it for jib middle & later part light airs
and variable the watch employed noting yards

Remarks on board Wednesday December 3rd 1843
these 24 hours commences with light airs and variable
the watch employed at ships duty middle & later
part moderate winds and fine weather saw
porpoises lat 30-35 N

Remarks on board Thursday December 4th 1843
these 24 hours commences with moderate winds from
the N steering 6 & 8 mile & later part light winds
and fine weather the watch employed at ships duty
lat 29-37 N

Remarks on board Friday December 5th 1843
these 24 hours commences with light winds from the
N steering 6 & 8 at 2 Pm saw the island
of Gaudy loof bairny 8 distance 10 leagues altered
the bear to S 6 & 8 mile & later part light airs
lat 29-36 N

Remarks on board Saturday December 6th 1843
these 24 hours commences with light airs and variable
and fine weather at 7 Pm the mile of Gaudy loof
bairny N 6 distance 8 leagues the watch employed
noting yards middle & later part light airs
lat 29-37 N

Remarks on board Sunday December 7th 1843
these 24 hours commences with light airs from the
the off 35 N and fine weather the watch employed at
ships duty middle & later part the same
lat 29-34 N

Remarks on board Monday December 11th 1843
these 24 hours commences with light airs and variable
with fine weather middle part the same at 2 Am
took & light breeze from the N 6 later part moderate
trails lat 27-33 N

Remarks on board Tuesday December 12th 1843
these 24 hours commences with light trails from the
N steering 6 & 8 sent up & main royal and bent
the old main sail stage the bottom below middle
& later part light trails and fine weather
lat 26-33 N

Remarks on board Wednesday December 13th 1843
these 24 hours commences with light trails from the
N & Eastward and fine weather set up the fore royal
the watch employed at ships duty middle & later part
light trails and fine weather
lat 26-30 N

Remarks on board Thursday December 14th 1843
these 24 hours commences with light trails from the
N to N and fine weather the watch employed at
ships duty at 11 Pm bent the fore top sail and
bent the old one middle & later part moderate trails
saw humpbacks lat

Remarks on board Friday December 15th 1843
these 24 hours commences with moderate trails with thick
over cast sent up the main royal & the watch employed
making spinnaker at 6 Pm the land bairny
from 6 to N 6 distance 10 leagues steering S 6 & 8
mile & later part light winds and variable and
sun rain no observation

Remarks on board Saturday December 16th 1843
these 24 hours commences with light winds and variable
with sun rain at 6 Pm the land bairny N 6
distance 9 leagues mile & later part moderate winds
and fine weather saw humpbacks the watch employed
at ships duty at 12 Am the land bairny from 6 to
N 6 distance 12 leagues
