First and middle light winds latter part fresh winds with fog Squalls

Monday the 10th Oct

First and middle fresh breezes with fog. Squalls latter clear and pleasant

Strong Westerly winds Steering North repairing sails

Latt 39° 34' S.

Wednesday the 12th Oct

Fresh westerly winds Steering North repairing sails. H. Birth Day

Commences with moderate weather Saw Blackfish put off could not strike sent up fore and mizzen top G masts bent an other mizzen top sail

Light winds and pleasant Saw blackfish put off could not strike Wind W.S.W. Steering North at 10 AM Saw Juan Fernandez bearing N.W. Dis 15 Leagues
