Saturday the 19<sup>th</sup> May

All these 24 hours fine pleasant breezes from the E. Steering W By N. Saw porpoises and birds Ends  
Lon By Cross 152° 29' 30 West Lat By Ob 00° 56 North

Sunday the 20<sup>th</sup> May

These 24 hours fine weather Steering W By N. Saw birds in abundance porpoises  
Lon By Ob 154° 29' 30 West  
Lon By Cross 154° 31' 15 "

Lat By Ob 1° 25 North

Monday the 21<sup>st</sup> May

These 24 hours commences with light breezes from the E Steering W By N. Saw a great number of birds porpoises. Broke out the hole cooked the provisions

Lon By Cross 156° 26' 30 at 4 P.M. Lat 1° 50 North

Tuesday the 22<sup>nd</sup> May 1832

These 24 hours commences with light breezes from the East Steering W By N. at 12 midnight have the head yards to the mast at Daylight the land 4 miles off Christmas isle  
Saw Birds and Small fish Ends

Friday the 23<sup>rd</sup> May 1832

These 24 hours commences with light breezes from the E. Steering W By N. at P.M. Doubled reefed the topsails have the head yds to the mast Saw birds & tide rips in abundance  
Lon at 1 P.M. 159° 01 West Lat By Ob 3° 15 North

Saturday the 24<sup>th</sup> May

These 24 hours commences with light air & calm at Daylight Steering W By N. at 9 A.M. Lon 159° 50 West  
Lat By Ob 3° 36 North

Friday the 25<sup>th</sup> May 1832.

These 24 hours commences with fresh squall middle and latter part light air and calm from the East Steering West Ends

Lon By Ob 160° 47' 30

Lon By Cross 160° 50' 00 Lat By Ob 3° 41 North

Saturday the 26<sup>th</sup> May

This 24 hours commences with light breezes and squally at 10 A.M. Saw whales put off. Struck 3 took 2 to the ship cut one in ends this day.
