from N.W. Breeze S.E. at 4
Am cleared up wine very to W
and S.W. Seas with strong Breeze
from South heavy to the Westward
Saw a great many Pinbacks

Strong Breeze and fine weather from
N.W. Breeze etc all sail Middle
the same Seas with a fresh S.E.
Breeze N.E. double reefed Top Sails

Sunday Feb 17th
Commenced with a fresh S.E. Breeze
N.E. at 4 Am Breeze etc all sail
Main Sail a Spanker Wind etc
Seas with strong Breeze and thick
weather from the N by the wine to
the S.E. No Obs

Monday Feb 18th
Commenced with strong Breeze
and thick hazy weather from E
at 4 moderate and Breeze
Seas fine and clear from N.W. and
W Breeze from etc to or all sail

Tuesday Feb 19th
Commenced fine weather wine
very to S.W. heading to the N
Seas with fresh Breeze and fine
weather from S.W. Breeze etc
all sail Saw a Sail from the S
