Thursday April 18th 1878
Commenced calm with a heavy swell from S.W. Middle calm and some light squalls from the Northward. Ends with fine weather and light breezes from N to E.S.E. all sail course N.W. and W by N.

Friday April 19th
Commenced with fresh breezes from N.E. to E. Course W.N.W. all sail. Middle fine weather from E.S.E. Course W.N.W. and N.W. by N all sail. Ends with strong breezes and veering to the S. Course S.W. by W all sail.

Long 78.10 W

Saturday April 20th
Commenced with strong breezes from S.S.W. Course N.W. by W all sail. Middle and latter fine weather and fresh breezes from S.W. and S.S.W. Course N.W. and N.W. by N all sail.

Sunday April 21st
Commenced with fine weather and fresh breezes from W.S.W. Course by the wind N.W. by N to N.W. all sail. Middle light and from S.S. Course N.W. ends with light breezes E.S.E. all sail. Sun 4 sails.

Monday April 22nd 1878
Commenced with fine weather and fresh breezes from S.E. and increasing to strong breeze course by the wind N.E. W all sail. Middle fresh breezes and thick rainy weather from S.E. by the wind to N.W. ends with a calm and thick fog. No Obs.

Tuesday April 23rd
Commenced calm and thick fog put out the Mast Boat. Middle took a fresh breeze from S.W. with fine rain by the wind to N.E. ends with the wind N.E. W heading S.E. 2 sail in light.
Lat 47.51 S
Long 79.39 W

Wednesday April 24th
Commenced with fresh breezes and thick hazy weather from N.W. and veering to W by the wind to the Northward. Middle veered to S.W. and South Course N. ends the same fresh breezes and fine weather.
Lat 45.46 S

Thursday April 25th
Commenced with moderate breezes from S. Course N all sail. Middle fresh breezes from S.E. Course N by W ends with fine weather from E. Employment breaking out for provisions and water fitting the Bow Boat with various jobs.
