and getting ready for water balking
the Pops Deck Starboard Watch on Liberty

Thursday May 9th
Bad thick rain North Storing
Casks and taking a little water
from the Water Boat - 7 Casks
the Caulks worked in a Day

Friday May 10th

Fine weather taking and storing
Water Starboard Watch on Liberty
all that went came off

Saturday May 11th

Thick and fine rain Storing off
the ship balking under the bow
Chains and under the Stern

Sunday May 12th

Fine weather Starboard Watch on Liberty

Monday May 13th

Stewart disordered work and taking off Bread Potatoes Onions

Fine weather Employed painting lower
Potatoes Onions

Tuesday May 14th

Fine weather took the rest of the potatoes
and water and 3 men that have shipped
Stowed the water all ready but the

Wednesday May 15th 1874

Fine weather getting ready to sail took
off 6 men that has shipped ship a book
and ship the book up Stowed all
ready but 2 more men had to get
took off some stores and small things

Thursday May 16th

Fine weather waiting for steam
have shot sail all made

Friday May 17th

Fine weather light breeze from the
Southward at 1 Capt Fisher came
on board took the Anchor and Stowed
down the Bay at 7 got over side of
the Heads wind South heading N.E.W.
at 8 took the Anchor on the rail and
ran the Chain below light Brees
and Popsy from the Southward by the
wind to the Westward Ends with
light breeze and fine weather Comp
Stowing and lashing Anchors with
various jobs

Mr Murray
came out of the
Calaboose from
absent from his
duty since
May the
6th

Saturday May 18th

Light breeze from S.E.W. light wind to
the Westward Ends with light Brees
and fine weather from the Westward all
sail dismasted covers Employed putting
out the cutting stage with various
jobs

Sunday May 19th

Commenced with heavy and Popsy
squalls Low on sail and black fish
ends light and balking area with
Popsy and fine rain
