

Remarks On Board Bark Lancer Of New Bedford

Thursday June 6<sup>th</sup> 1878  
Commences with Strong Breezes and  
thick weather from N.W. Wind with  
Strong Breezes and heavy Squalls from  
the Westward Hood in under the lee of  
the Island to go a fishing to sugar

Friday June 7<sup>th</sup>  
Commences fresh Gale and a  
heavy Thunder storm at 7 Capt  
off G.S.C. Easy Sail at day-  
light close to Juan Fernandez  
went in to get some Wood to  
sugar went a fishing and Spouting

Saturday June 8<sup>th</sup>  
Commences Squally at 7 light  
aces from S.W. off and in Boats  
came off at 4 got about 200 fine  
fish. Middle the same off and on  
in the morning Capt Fisher  
went in with 13 Boats for Wood  
tried at both landings but  
to sugar came on Board took  
up the Boats blowing Strong from  
N.W.

Sunday June 9<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with Strong Breezes  
from N.W. off and on Middle  
Strong Breezes and veering to  
N.W. W and S. Breezes calm  
Lane in light to S.S.E.

Monday June 10<sup>th</sup> 1878  
Commences Calm Lane with fresh  
Breezes and sugar got in to the Lane and  
got off 2 Boat loads of Wood

Tuesday June 11<sup>th</sup>  
Strong Breezes and sugar from W got  
off 2 Boat loads of Wood had to give  
it up to sugar Middle thick and  
sugar at 8 got in to the Lane and got  
off 4 Boat loads of Wood wine veering  
to S.W. blowing Strong with heavy rain  
Squalls

Wednesday June 12<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with Strong Squalls from  
S.W. heading to the Westward Short sail  
Middle the same Lane with Strong  
Breezes and sugar from N.W. Short  
Sail employed at various jobs

Thursday June 13<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with Strong Breezes  
and sugar from N.W. by the wind  
to the Westward throughout the day  
the same saw small furrow Emperor  
Stowing over Between Decks

Friday June 14<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with Strong Breezes  
from N.W. at 7 Mass fisher line at  
7 1/2 dist 8 miles off Lane with  
Strong Breezes from N.W. to W and  
S.W. time to close to Mass fisher
