the Rigging and filling and repairing
a New Overhead Boat

Saturday July 20th
Commences with fine weather
from E by the wind to the Northward
Tides with fresh and light Bores
from E by the wind Opposite Tacks

Sunday July 21st
Commences with fine weather
and light Bore from E
Ends with light- ares and
fine weather from the Eastward

Commences with light ares and

light ares and thick Clouds weather
from S.E. all day to E.S.E. No Obs

Tuesday July 23rd
Commences with light ares and

strong Bores with thick and
rainy weather from E.S.E.
Lat- 19.31 S
Long 91.28 W

Wednesday July 24th
Commences with strong Bores
and rainy weather from E.S.E.
Nothing in Light- Employed Painting
a Overhead Boat with various
jobs Ends strong Trade and
fine weather Employed Fitting a
New Boat

Thursday July 25th
Strong Trade and fine weather
Ends thick and hazy from the
Eastward Employed on the Boat
and rigging No Obs

Friday July 26th
Commences with strong Bores
and thick hazy weather from
E Easy Sail by the wind Opposite
Tacks Ends the same
