Ship and clearing up hull and  
Latter fine weather from East  
Steaming off to the Westward Employed  
making Boat Sails Carpentery

Friday Aug 9<sup>th</sup>  
Fine weather from E Steaming off  
West full sunsett luffed to to the  
Northward Under with fresh Trades  
and fine weather

Saturday Aug 10<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with fresh Trades  
and fine weather Employed at  
various jobs Under with strong  
Trades and raged  
Lat 20-00 S  
Long 92-57 W

Sunday Aug 11<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with strong Trades  
and raged Saw a great many  
Squirrels throughout there 24  
hours the same  
Lat 19-52 S  
Long 92-16 W

Monday Aug 12<sup>th</sup> 1878  
Commenced with strong Bores and  
Squally from S.S.E heading to N.E. Saw  
many Squirrels Middle and latter  
the same Employed making Boat Sails  
reparing main stay sail

Tuesday Aug 13<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with strong Trades  
and raged nothing in light  
Under with strong Bores and  
Squally and fine rain

Wednesday Aug 14<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with strong Trades  
and squally Saw many  
Squirrels throughout there 24  
hours strong Bores and raged  
Employed reparing fore stay sail  
making Boat Sails with various  
jobs  
Lat 19-10 S  
Long 92-45 W

Thursday Aug 15<sup>th</sup>  
strong Bores and fine weather  
Middle the same latter moderate  
at meridian nearly calm

Friday Aug 16<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced calm Under with  
light baffling and Employed  
reparing the fore topsail  
Lat  
Long
