Monday Aug 26th 1878
Commenced light airs and Calms
throughout light baffling airs
and Calms employed repairing
the Old Fore Sail

Tuesday Aug 27th
Fine weather with light baffling
airs to work on the Fore Sail
ends with light and baffling airs
and sent the Fore Sail and took
in the fifth for repairs

Wednesday Aug 28th
Commenced with fine weather
and light Breezes from E to ESE
by the wind to the S.E. all Sail
comes with fine weather Steady
Breezes from N.E. by the wind E.S.E.
all Sail employed at various
jobs Carpentery &c &c

Lat 30.45 S
Long 87.09 W

Thursday Aug 29th
Commenced with fine weather
and pleasant Breezes from N.E.
all Sail by the wind E.S.E. Ends
with fresh Breezes and Cloudy

Friday Aug 30th
Strong Breezes and Cloudy weather
from N.E. and veering to N course
& by N all Sail. Ends with thick
weather from the Westward

Saturday Aug 31st 1878
Commenced with thick heavy
weather from N.S.W. by the wind to
the S. Easy Sail. Ends with
Fresh Breezes from W Course S.E.

Sunday Sept 1st 1878
Commenced with fresh breezes and
thick weather from W. Steady off to
S.E. the fore Sail at daylight
comes fine at daylight. Saw the
Island of Massachusetts bearing S.E.

Monday Sept 2nd
Commenced with fine weather
and light Breezes from W. and
N.S.W. by the wind. Spent the
day on the land and one Sail in light.
Ends fine weather. Sailed with
the Private King

Tuesday Sept 3rd
Light Breezes and fine weather
from S and S.W. Sailed about 30 miles
Ends with fine weather from the
Southward

Wednesday Sept 4th
Commenced with fine weather
from the Southward the Lancer in
light. Ends with strong Breezes
and night from S.E. the
Island bearing S. one Sail in
light
