Saturday Sept 14th 1878
Commenced with fine weather
from the S and veering to S E by the
wind Oposite tack 3 men laid
up sick or lame Enrolled the same
Ends Calm Employed repairing a Boat
Lat 36.20 S
Long 75.52 W

Sunday Sept 15th
Commenced with a light Breeze
from N.W.W heading to S E Ends with
fine weather from W.W.W Sailed
with the Nautilus & James Allen

Monday Sept 16th
Commenced with fine weather
from N.W.W 3 Sails in Light
Ends with fine weather from W.W.W
6 Sails in Light Employed repairing
the Boat Lat 36.14 S
Long 76.49 W

Tuesday Sept 17th
Commenced with fresh Breezes and
fine weather from E.W one Sail in
Light Ends with thick squally
weather

Wednesday Sept 18th
Commenced with thick weather
Saw the Matilda Sears chasing
a Whale that they had Shedd before
Ends with fine weather but a
heavy swell from S.W Employed
repairing a Boat
Lat 36.26 S
Long 74.03 W

Thursday Sept 19th 1878
Commenced with fresh Breezes and
fine weather from S Saw many
Spinbacks Filled 5 Sails in Light
Ends with fresh Breezes and fine
weather from the Southwest fine then
repairing the Boat Saw many Spinbacks

Friday Sept 20th
Commenced with strong Breezes
and fine weather 4 Sails in Light
Ends with fresh Breezes from S
Course W all Sail
Lat 35.30 S
Long 77.09 W

Saturday Sept 21st
Commenced with fresh Breezes
and fine weather from S Course
W all Sail Ends with strong
Breezes and fine weather they off
to N.W and W.W.W

Sunday Sept 22nd
Commenced with fresh Breezes
from the S.W and veering to S Saw
the Island of Juan Fernandez far
W.W.W throughout the same

Monday Sept 23rd
Fine weather from S by the wind Oposite
tacks at 7 Juan Fernandez far
from E.W to W.W.W dist 30 miles
Ends fine then in for the Lancer
got a 100 lbs Water Casks ready to
go on shore
