

Remarks On Board Bark Larzer Of New

Tuesday Sept 24th 1878
Commenced with fine weather and
light breezes from S.W. got in and
sent the raft ashore and starting
pull the dorying off and on in
company Middle and latter off and
on took off the water 13 Casks

Wednesday Sept 25th
Fine weather with light baffling
and cheyler from S and E got all
ready to get more water and
wood ends with light and
calms 3 boats ashore for wood

Thursday Sept 26th
Commenced with light and
calms at dusk took off
a lighter load of wood Middle
kick and squally ends strong
breezes from the Northward took
off 4 Casks of water stowing away
wood

Friday Sept 27th
Strong breezes from the Northward
bleating E. S. to easy S.W.
ends with strong breezes and
squally from W. Course E.
Lat 35° 06' S
Long 75° 43' W

Saturday Sept 28th
Strong breezes and squally from W
Course E. and E. S. ends the same
Employment at various jobs

Sunday Sept 29th 1878
Commenced with strong breezes and
swept from W Course E. S. luffed to
at dusk to the S.W. with double
reefed top sails. Fine weather
Nothing in light

Monday Sept 30th
Commenced with fine weather from
S.W. Course E. S. ends with strong
breezes and fine weather from S
heading to W.S.W

Tuesday Oct 1st 1878
Commenced with strong breezes
and fine weather from S by the
wind to the Westward ends with
fine weather from S steering off on
different courses from N.E. and N.W.
Lat 35° 46' S
Long 75° 03' W

Wednesday Oct 2nd
Commenced with fresh breezes from
S Employed at various jobs
ends with light breezes from the
Westward

Thursday Oct 3rd
Commenced with light and
calms ends with light and
calms Employed repairing
the Spar with various jobs
