

Remarks On Board Bark Lancer Of New

Friday Oct 4th 1878
Commenced with light air and fine weather from S.W. Saw 2 Sails Ends with light Breezes and fine weather from the Southward Saw a great many Humpbacks

Saturday Oct 5th
Commenced with fine weather from S by the wind Oposh Jacks Saw a great many Humpbacks 2 Sails in light breeze with light air and thick fog

Sunday Oct 6th
Commenced with light S.W. winds and foggy Middle Foggy Ends Foggy and light air and calm
Lat. 36.51 S
Long 74.39 W

Monday Oct 7th
Commenced with light air from N.W. and veering to W. Breeze S.W. Ends with light air from S.W. at daylight the Island of Noche bore S.W. by S stood in for it.

Tuesday Oct 8th
Light air standing in for the Island at 4 Capt Fisher went on shore came off at 6 Middle off and on at 7 stood in and anchored in 10 fathoms took 4 loads of Potatoes fine weather

Wednesday Oct 9th 1878
Fine weather from S.W. took off 2 live sheep and a Haughton's Bullock at 3 took the Anchor and kept off N.W. for Tatchuana Middle fresh Breezes and fine weather from the Southward N.W. Breeze with light Breezes and fine weather making down along the land for Tatchuana

Thursday Oct 10th
Fine weather at 3 got inside of the Island of Tatchuana Capt Fisher took a boat and went up to town worked the ship about one half way and anchored in 10 fathoms Discharged Mr Fisher's Tons fine weather took off 10 bags of Broad Stone Sugar and Coffee 3rd Mate and 2 men Lick discharged Mr Fisher and 2 men Manuel and Robert

Friday Oct 11th
Fine weather from the Southward Ends fine weather employed repairing the main sail

Saturday Oct 12th
Commenced with fine weather and fresh Breezes from the Southward Employed repairing M. J. S. Sail Ends the same employed at various jobs

Sunday Oct 13th
Fine weather Ends thick and foggy from N.W. with fine rain
