

Remarks On Board Bark Laricer Of New

Monday Oct 14th 1878

Commences fine weather from W
Middle Foggy Seas with a thick Mother

Tuesday Oct 15th

Commences with a well stormy
Norther Boat went on shore after the
3rd Mate and men that had shipped
Manuel on of the boat absent himself
the boat came off with the 3rd Mate and
2 men Middle stormy Seas fine
at about 9 Capt. Fisher came off in
a shore boat bringing off another
man we took the anchor worked
out of the Bay light-ases from West

Manuel
absent himself
from the boat on
duty has diverted

Wednesday Oct 16th

Commences with light-ases
from West W to NW at 7 wind at
W got out side the Head went
and threw the Starboard Anchor
Middle light-ases and Calms Lane
in light

Thursday Oct 17th

Commences with light-ases
and increasing from S heading to
the Westward all sail down with
fast and light-ases and fine
weather from S.S.W to S Opposite Jacks

Friday Oct 18th

Fine weather from the Southward
all sail by the wind Opposite Jacks
Saw 3 sails Middle and latter the
same

Saturday Oct 19th 1878

Commences with fine weather from
S.W to W.S.W all sail to the Southward
Saw 2 sails watch's compass at evening
jobs Tomas with light-ases and Calms
working to the S

Sunday Oct 20th

Commences calm at 2 took a light
Boat from the Westward heading to
S.S.W all sail the Island of Nocha
in light-ases S.C Middle stormy
Boat from W course S.S.W Seas with
a fresh Gale and heavy Squalls from
S.W double reefed 3rd sails

Monday Oct 21st

Commences with a fresh Gale
and fine weather from S.W by
the wind to S.S.E Middle the same
to strong Boats with fine rain
Squalls from W course and S
by S all sail

Tuesday Oct 22nd

Commences with strong Boats
at 6 veering to W.S.W with
Squalls double reefed the 3rd
Sails rendered main sail with
and Spreader Course S.S.E
Middle strong Gale from West W course
a heavy Gale from W and veering to
W.S.W sure to double reefed main
3rd sail and strong stay sails bad
Sea and heavy Squalls
