W.S.W and veering to S.W here to on the
Starboard Tack to S.S.E Middle Moderate
Winer W. Oners fine weather all sail
to the S

Thursday Oct 24th
Commenced with fine Brees and
Foggy and fine rain Squalls from W
heaving to the Southward all sail
Ones with fresh Brees and Squally
wind veering to S veered Ship to the
W double reefed 2^d Sails

Friday Oct 25th
Commenced strong Brees at 7
fresh Gale from S heaving to the
W blew reefed Main 1st Sail and
Storm Stay Sails Middle the same
Ones with strong Brees with frequent
Squalls with rain

Saturday Oct 26th
Commenced strong Brees and
veered from S.S.W and S.W by
the wind Obvise Tacks Ones light
and fine weather from S

Sunday Oct 27th
Commenced light air from S.S.E
Middle wind heaving to the S
Course S all sail Ones the
same fine clear weather

Monday Oct 28th 1878
Commenced with fine weather and
light Brees and fine weather from
S. Course W.S.W Ones fine veered to
the N heaving to the Eastward all sail

Tuesday Oct 29th
Commenced with fine weather from
the N Course to S.S.E nothing in
light Ones with fine weather
from the N Saw 3 Right Whales
Lowered 3 Boats took one got it
to the Ship at Meridian 1000 mounted
brought to by 6 dist 30 miles



Wednesday Oct 30th
Fine weather from the Northward
but the Whale Middle heavy
rain all night Ones thick and
hazy from S.E. to N and
N.W. Started the Works

Thursday Oct 31st
Commenced with thick hazy
weather with fine rain and Foggy
Squalls from N.W to W Emptied
Boiling Middle thick Ones with
thick and fine rain

Friday Nov 1st
Commenced with fine weather from
S.W Emptied Boiling Middle
Calm Ones Squally rainy from
S.W finished Boiling
