

Remarks On Board Bark Lancer Of New

Wednesday Nov 13th 1878
Strong Breezes Middle a gale of wind
and rain from the West by N
had to cool down and fine
Boiling

Thursday Nov 14th
Commenced with fine weather
from W finished Boiling the Whales
Head Middle had a Thunder Storm
and Specially knocking out to star
down and equal quantity
of Oil 40 lbs Each Ship

Friday Nov 15th
Commenced with fine weather
from the W.S.W. heading at W by the
wind employed Steaming down in
the Star Hatch and with fine
weather employed cleaning Bone
Lat. 44.59 S
Long 77.48 W

Saturday Nov 16th
Commenced with fine weather
from W.S.W. by the wind to the S all
Sail and with strong breezes
employed Washing Bone

Sunday Nov 17th
Commenced with strong
breezes from S.W. opposite
Jacks by the wind and sail
and with strong breezes from S
and had very weather

Monday Nov 18th 1878
All these 24 hours strong breezes from
S and a heavy sea from S.W.
Spoke the Milton and thick with
heavy foggy squalls No Obs

Tuesday Nov 19th
Strong Breezes once thick fog then
from S and with Milton
and Jersey Perry and with
light and with heavy weather

Wednesday Nov 20th
Commenced calm 3 sails in light
and with strong breezes from
N.W. at 11.30 Sun 2 right Whales
lowered 3 Boats thick heavy weather

Thursday Nov 21st
Strong Breezes once very rough
struck a Whale but ~~did not~~ and
let him go at 4 found bad
could not hall to him ~~got~~ the
Boat Steve split ~~Sabotage~~
Speaks and with a Sol from
W
Lat. 45.10 S
Long 80.21 W

Friday Nov 22nd
Commenced with a fresh Gale
and heavy squalls from N.W. by
Middle light and and with strong
breezes and fine weather from S
by the wind to the Eastward
