Commenced with a fresh Sale
and fine weather from S.W.
Nothing in sight. Tens with a
strong Sale and gradually
Lat. 44.59 S
Long 84.21 W

Wednesday Dec 25th
Commenced with a fresh Sale
and had thick weather from S.W.
Oposite Jacks have two Middle
strong Sale thick and rainy.
Tens clear blowing strong hander
More top sail

Thursday Dec 26th
Strong Sale from S.W. and clear
double reefed M.J. sail and
Storm S.S. Sails Middle moderate
Lot double reefed Tens strong
Bress and fine weather

Friday Dec 27th
Commenced with Bress and fine
weather. Sailed with the force
from J.A. Howard and a Middle
Tens thick foggy weather from
W.S.W. thick sail
No Obs

Saturday Dec 28th 1878
At Meridian the fog cleared up
some made sail. Bress S.C.
at 4 thick with strong Bress
from W.S.W. at 7 short sail and
hauled by the wind. S. Jack Middle
had a fresh Sale Tens strong Sale
and clear weather from S.W. here
to be the Westward Lat. 46.25 S
Long 84.35 W

Sunday Dec 29th
Commenced with strong Sale
from S.W. heading to the Westward
double reefed M.J. sail and
Storm stay sails. Middle moderating
Lot double reefed J.P. sails. Bress
S.C. Tens the same

Monday Dec 30th
Commenced with a fresh Sale
with fine clear weather. Saw 2
Sails Tens with a fresh Sale
and clear weather. Saw a number
of ships all steering to the Northward
Lat. 46.11 S
Long 83.14 W

Tuesday Dec 31st
Commenced with a Sale but it
moderating. Lot double reefed J.P.
Sails fifth and spanker shipped
More top sails. Tens with fine
weather from W.S.W. Steaming off
departs. Commenced to the Westward
all sail nothing in sight
Lat 46.00 S
Long 82.30 W
