on there to be first the mother's share
on the East Whistle

Thursday Mch 20th
Fine weather Employed at various jobs
had a new Steel Pins made for the lower
Cutting Blocks Seased them in and finished
up the cutting gear

Friday Mch 21st
Right Foggy and heavy Employed repairing
the Old Bear Sails with other small jobs

Saturday Mch 22nd
Foggy with light N Winds finished
and bent the Bear Sails

Sunday Mch 23th
Fine weather Starboard Watch on Liberty

Monday Mch 24th
Fine weather all then 24 hours washed
the ship

Tuesday Mch 25th
Fine weather waiting for the recovery of
the Capt. and for a crew

Wednesday Mch 26th
Fine weather drying sails with other
jobs

Thursday Mch 27th
Fine weather Nothing doing waiting orders

Friday Mch 28th 1879
These 24 hours thick some part raining
Nothing doing waiting orders

Saturday Mch 29th
Capt Fisher getting better | Fine weather drying sails took off some
Small stores got a Blubber Hook from the
Emma & Jones

Sunday Mch 30th
Durib Jones broke | Fine weather Port watch on Liberty
his Liberty has
come on board again

Monday Mch 31st
Fine weather Employed setting up the
Rigging Painting Bends with other jobs

Tuesday April 1st 1879
A man was call | Fine weather took on board some traps
Boardsil deserted | got from 2 ships

Wednesday April 2nd
Some part fine Mostly Northerly heavy
with rain and a sudden shift to the
Westward

Thursday April 3rd
Fine weather drying sails and taking off
small things from the store

Friday April 4th
All these 24 fine weather Employed washing
ship in side to paint some parts

Saturday April 5th
Fine weather Employed scraping off the
rough paint - inside ready for painting
