

# Remarks On Board Bark Lancer Of

Thursday June 15<sup>th</sup> 1879  
Commenced with light airs with  
hazy weather Steaming down the  
Lance at 4 o'clock to the wind  
off Pata Head off and on tides  
with light breezes off and on Pata Head

Monday June 16<sup>th</sup>

The Bark Lancer  
has to day transferred  
to H B Chase late mate  
for the present

Commenced with fresh sea breezes got  
close in to try to get Capt Fisher on  
shore tomorrow tides light breeze and  
Sea breezes got in to try to get Capt Fisher  
went on shore with his things to go  
Home shipped or transferred the ship  
for the present to H B Chase the mate  
for 2 months more or less

Tuesday June 17<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fresh breezes from  
the S to S.W the last boat in Capt  
Fisher's Service came off heeled out  
by the wind to the Westward all sail  
Ones light trades by the wind to S.W  
all sail employed covering the new  
Deliver

Lat 5-40 S  
Long 82-59 W

Wednesday June 18<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fine weather  
and light trades by the wind to  
S.W Ones with light trades well  
to the S by the wind to S.W and  
W.S.W all sail employed on the  
Rigging

Lat 5-47 S  
Long 84-46 W

Thursday June 19<sup>th</sup> 1879

Commenced with fresh trades and cloudy  
weather heading S.W and S.W by S all sail  
Ones with fresh trades with squally weather  
Foggy squalls and fine rain

Lat 5-18 S  
Long 85-58 W

Friday June 20<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fresh trades well  
to the S from S.W by S saw many finbacks  
Ones fresh trades and squally weather  
steering S.W

Lat 9-18 S  
Long 87-17 W

Saturday June 21<sup>st</sup>

Strong trades and squally fine rain  
steering off S.W easy sail Ones with  
squally trades

Lat 9-55 S  
Long 88-22 W

Sunday June 22<sup>nd</sup>

Strong trades and squally weather  
saw a great many finbacks  
throughout the day

Lat 10-14 S  
Long 89-50 W

Monday June 23<sup>rd</sup>

Commenced squally foggy and fine  
rain finbacks in light Ones  
with strong trades opposite Jacks  
by the wind

Lat 10-16 S  
Long 89-41 W
