Tuesday June 24th 1879
Commenced with strong trades
with squally weather. Double reefed
top sails to the southward
and with fresh trades and squally
Lat 11.47 S
Long 90.36 W

Wednesday June 25th
Fresh trades, well to the E and squally
by the wind to the S. Trades with squally
weather. Oposite tracks by the wind
Lat 13.20 S
Long 90.47 W

Thursday June 26th
Commenced squally from E to
E. S. E. Trades fine weather. Saw
Hindbacks
Lat 12.19 S
Long 89.59 W

Friday June 27th
Strong breezes and squally to
the E. S. E. all sail throughout
squally
Lat 11.06 S
Long 89.44 W

Saturday June 28th
Commenced with squally from
E. S. E. all sail to the southward
Trades fine. Employed filling water
forward to join ship. Lat 12.27 S
Long 89.07 W

Sunday June 29th
Commenced with fresh trades and
fine weather from E. S. E. all sail to
the S. Trades strong trades
Lat 13.57 S
Long 89.47 W

Monday June 30th 1879
Commenced strong trades E. S. E. by the
wind to the southward. Trades the same
Lat 15.47 S
Long 90.30 W

Tuesday July 1st 1879
Commenced with fresh trades from
E. S. E. to the S by the wind. Trades thick and
raining
Lat 15.53 S
Long 91.09 W

Wednesday July 2nd
Commenced thick and raining from E. S. E.
at 4 cleared up and rain clearing to S. E.
with fine weather. Trades fine. Oposite
tracks
Lat 15.54 S
Long 90.35 W

Thursday July 3rd
Commenced with light trades
and fine weather. Trades with light
and baffling airs. Employed picking
over the potatoes
Lat 16.37 S
Long 89.50 W

Friday July 4th
Commenced with light breezes
from S heading to the eastward all
sail. Trades fine
Lat 16.41 S
Long 89.32 W

Saturday July 5th
Commenced fine weather from E. S. E.
heading E by the wind all sail
Trades fine weather from S heading to the
eastward all sail
Lat 16.48 S
Long 89.13 W
