Sunday July 6th 1879
Commenced with fine weather from
the Southward heading to the Eastward
all sail saw a great many birds
Tends fine weather Trade S.E. heading
to the Eastward all sail

Commenced with fine weather and
light Trades veering S.W. to the Southward
Tends with strong Trades and fine weather

Lat 17.33 S

Tuesday July 8th
Commenced with strong Trades
and fine weather heading to the
S.W. Tends with fresh Trades and
squally weather Course S.W.

Lat 18.30 S
Long 87.48 W

Wednesday July 9th
Commenced with fresh Trades
and squally Tends with cloudy
weather

Lat 19.20 S

Thursday July 10th
Commenced moderate Trades and
cloudy heavy off S.W. then sail
Tends the same heavy off W. S.
Short sail

Long 90.18 W

Friday July 11th 1879
Commenced with fresh Trades from
E. heavy off W. S. Short sail
Tends thick and squally weather Ensigns
reparing the jib

Lat 19.57 S
Long 91.00 W

Saturday July 12th
Commenced with thick heavy weather
from the E. heading to N.W. Short
sail Tends with fresh Trades and fine
weather Course S.W.

Lat 19.35 S
Long 91.12 W

Sunday July 13th
Commenced with strong Trades from
E. S.W. and squally Tends with heavy
squally weather from E. heavy off S.W.
Short sail

Lat 19.44 S
Long 92.48 W

Monday July 14th
Strong Trades and squally from
E. nothing in light Tends
with thick and squally weather

Lat 19.20 S
Long 92.28 W

Tuesday July 15th
Commenced with squally weather
by the wind Short sail Tends the
same thick and squally weather
by the wind to the Northward
