Sunday July 27th 1879
Commenced with thick and squally
from S.E. to S.W. double reefed fore sails
Ended the same squally weather
Lat 13.00 S
Long 86.49 W

Monday July 28th
Commenced with fresh breeze from
S.E. to S.W. some light squalls
of rain and fog. Ends moderate and
squally by the wind to the S.W. Short sail
Lat 12.12 S
Long 85.47 W

Tuesday July 29th
Commenced with light squally from
S.E. to the S.W. by the wind
Ended sunny Lat 11.21 S
Long 84.49 W

Wednesday July 30th
Commenced with squally weather
from S.E. thick foggy and fine
rain. Ends with fresh trade and
fine weather heading into the S.W.
Lat 10.36 S
Long 83.47 W

Thursday July 31st
Commenced with fresh trade and
fine weather. Saw Humpbacks
Ended fine weather. Employed faving
down fore rigging. Saw many Hump
and Finbacks
Lat 9.57 S
Long 82.50 W

Friday Aug 1st 1879
Commenced with fresh breeze Employed
faving down the main rigging. Ends with
cloudy weather. Employed faving down
Lat 9.47 S

Saturday Aug 2nd
Fine weather finished faving down
Ends with cloudy heavy weather. Employed
cleaning out the scuttle butt and getting
out water faving salt water for ballast
Lat 9.15 S
Long 81.49 W

Sunday Aug 3rd
Commenced with heavy cloudy weather
from S.E. by the wind to S.W. Easy
Sail. Ends fine weather. Saw many Fin
and Humpbacks Lat 9.33 S
Long 81.22 W

Monday Aug 4th
Commenced with fine weather from
S.E. by the wind to S.W. Ends with thick
and heavy weather by the wind to S.W.
Short sail Lat 9.43 S
Long 81.52 W

Tuesday Aug 5th
Commenced with fresh trade and
thick heavy weather. Netting in light
Ended the same Lat 9.47 S
Long 81.22 W

Wednesday Aug 6th
Commenced with strong trade and
thick heavy weather. Ends with light
light trade. Employed reefing fore
sail. Course set to N.W.
Lat 9.15 S
Long 81.34 W
