Commenced with squally hazy
weather. Employed repairing sails
shifted fore top sails. Oneas fine
employed repairing fore top sail

Wednesday Aug 20th
Commenced with light Trades
with some light foggy squalls
Oneas with fresh Trades and
fine weather. Employed repairing
sails. Shifted Waste Boat
Lat 12° 46' S
Long 90° 29' W

fine weather. Employed at various
jobs. Oneas with strong Trades
and fine weather
Lat 16° 31' S
Long 92° 35' W

Saturday Aug 23rd
Commenced with strong Trades
and fine weather heading S to
S.W. all sail employed at various
jobs fitting the boat. Oneas
de Oneas with fresh Trades and
squally weather

Sunday Aug 24th
Commenced with fresh Trades
and squally heading up S and
S.W. all sail. Oneas heading
from S to S.W. all sail
Lat 20° 36' S
Long 93° 45' W

Monday Aug 25th
Commenced with light Bours
from S by the wind S.W. all sail
Oneas with light airs and calms
employed caulking some boards
that need it.
