N.W. Course S.W. all Sail
Ends the same Saw 2 Sails one bound
to the Southward one to the Northward

from N.W. Course S.W. all Sail
Clear light airs and Calms Employed
separating main Sail

Thursday Sept 4th
Commenced with Calm finished
and bent the main Sail Ends
with a dead Calm

Friday Sept 5th
Commenced Calm Employed repairing
2 Top S. Sails Shifted main Top S.
Sail Ends with light Breezes and
fine weather from the N.E. by the
wind S.E. all Sail Employed
at various jobs
