from S.E. to S.E. ends with
strong breezes from S.E. all sail
to S.S.E. employees repairing
sails with various jobs

Commences with strong breezes
S.E. to S.S.E. all sail to the Eastward
Middle and latter strong breezes
from the Northwester all sail to end

from S to S.W. breeze S by S
ends strong breezes and fine weather
from the S by the wind to the Eastward

watches employees at various jobs
ends with fresh breezes from the
North by the wind to S.E. all sail

Commences with fresh breezes
and fine weather from S all sail
to the Eastward ends with fresh
breezes at 10 am The Island of
Mass. Sunda being S.E. by S breeze
S.E. ends heavy and squally

Commences with heavy weather
baffling from S to S.W. Middle
baffling winds ends with light
breezes from S.E. with fog and
rain squalls heading to the S.E. all sail
