Thursday Oct 23rd 1879
Commenced with light airs and foggy
from N.W. S.W. Middle calm ends with
light airs from the Westward Land in
light
Lat 46° 29' S
Long 76° 38' W

Friday Oct 24th
Commenced with light airs and fine
weather from N.W. at 4 pm strong breezes
from N heading to N.W. Ends with
thick raining from N.W. Short Sail
No Obs

Saturday Oct 25th
Commenced with fresh Breezes
and thick rain from N heading
to S.S.W. Short Sail Ends with fine
weather from S.W. Course N.E. all
Sail
Lat 46° 07' S
Long 77° 06' W

Sunday Oct 26th
Commenced with fine weather from
S.W. Course N.E. got all Sail till
Sunset Ends with a fresh Gale
and heavy rain from N.W. to
S.W. at Meridian cleared up
Lat 45° 32' S

Monday Oct 27th
Commenced with a fresh Gale
and thick hazy weather from S.W.
Oposite Jacks Short Sail Ends fine
from S.W. Course N.E. got all Sail
Island Secora being N.E. to
Lat 45° 04' S

Tuesday Oct 28th 1879
Commenced with fine weather from
N.S.W. Steady along the Land at dusk
hauled off here saw a great many
Humpbacks Shifted the fore Sail
Ends with fresh breezes from the Westward
with thick and hazy weather with rain
and foggy squalls No Obs

Wednesday Oct 29th
Commenced with strong breezes and
thick squally weather veering to S.W.
and S saw many Humpbacks
Middle thick and squally Ends fine
from the S Steady in E.S.E. for the
Land saw it at 9 am
Lat 44° 59' S
Long 75° 33' W

Thursday Oct 30th
Commenced with fine weather from
S at 4 pm Land bore S.E. dist 10
miles Ends with thick foggy
weather from N.W. No Obs

Friday Oct 31st
Commenced with fresh breezes
and raining foggy weather from
N.W. Ends thick and foggy

Saturday Nov 1st
Commenced with thick foggy and
rain Ends with strong breezes
and clear weather from W heavy
swell from S
Lat 44° 46' S
Long 77° 25' W
