 Jacks by the wind Ends with a fresh
 Gale with thick rainy weather from
 W to S.W. hove to close reef 3rd sails
 Lat 44.39 S

Monday Nov 3rd
 Commences with a Gale and thick
 rainy from S.W. heading to N.W.
 Close reef 3rd sails Middle Moderate
 Ends with a fresh Gale and thick
 weather No Obs

Tuesday Nov 4th
 Commences with a fresh Gale
 from W.S.W. thick Hazy weather
 Middle and latter Strong Gale from
 W thick and foggy in Squalls
 Lat 43.04 S
 Long 77.03 W

Wednesday Nov 5th
 Commences with a heavy Gale from
 W heading to the Northward Close
 reefed Main Top Sail and Storming
 Sails clear weather Middle Moderate
 Ends with light air and Calms
 Lat 42.31 S

Thursday Nov 6th
 Commences with light. Belling and
 and Calms at 4 took a light Boreas
 from N.W. Course S.W. all sail
 Middle Fresh Gale and Squally Ends
 Moderate 3rd South reefed Courses
 Gibb and Sprung
 Lat 42.16 S

Friday Nov 7th 1879
 Commences with Boreas and light Boreas
 from the Westward heading to the Northward
 at 7 reefing to S.W. reefed Ship to the Southward
 Middle fine weather from N Course S.W.
 latter wind increasing to a Gale at 11
 Close reefed Main Top Sail
 No Obs

Saturday Nov 8th
 Commences with a Strong Gale from
 N at 2 reefed to N.W. Moderate some
 still thick weather. Ends with a Strong
 Gale and heavy Squalls from West
 Lat 44.00 S
 Long 79.42 W

Sunday Nov 9th
 Commences with a Strong Gale from
 W Close reefed Main Top Sail and
 Storm Slay Sails Middle Moderate
 Ends fine weather from N.S.W.
 Lat 43.52 S

Monday Nov 10th
 Commences with fine weather from
 N.S.W. heading to the S heavy head
 swell running Ends with fresh
 Gale from N.S.W. double reefed 3rd
 Sails
 Lat 43.16 S
 Long 80.15 W

Tuesday Nov 11th
 Commences with Strong Boreas from
 W to S.W. by the wind Sheet Sail
 Ends with Strong Boreas and
 rough from W Sea a Right Whale
 lower h. & started without success
 to chase saw one bark
 Lat 43.22 S
