Saturday Nov 22nd 1879
Commenced with fine weather from
S. Ensign Boiling Opposite Jacks
Ones with fine weather from N. Saw
one right Whale lower 3 boats but
without Success Saw 3 Sails

Sunday Nov 23rd
Fine weather from N. fine weather
Boiling 60 lbs Ones with light ones
and fine weather



Line parted

Monday Nov 24th
Commenced with light ones from
the Northwest Saw one Whale lower
3 Boat going quick no chance
Ones strong Boers and bad weather
lower struck a Whale line parted
No Obs

Tuesday Nov 25th
Strong Boers and thick sailing
from N to N.W. Spoke the Northwest
Boiling a large Sperm Whale
No Obs

Wednesday Nov 26th
Commenced with bad thick only
weather from N.W. Short sail
Middle thick and rainy ones
fine weather from the Southwest
Saw 2 sails lower to the Northwest
Lat. 45.50 S
Long 80.55 W

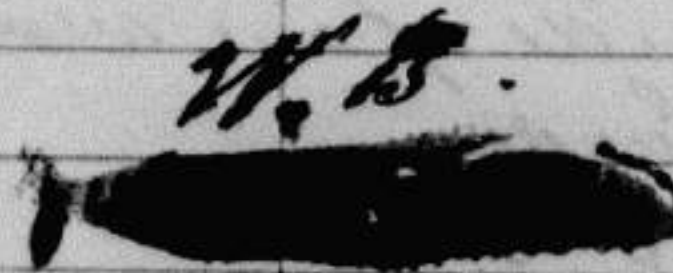


Thursday Nov 27th 1879
Commenced with fine weather from
S. Saw a number of sails no Whales
Ones with strong Boers and fine weather
from N. Saw one Whale going to windward
quick no chance

Friday Nov 28th
Commenced with fine weather from the
Westward 8 ships in light. Lancer with
John & Winthrop Middle fresh Boers
from the Westward Ones light ones from
S.W. 2 sail in light

Saturday Nov 29th
Commenced with light ones from
S.W. 5 sails in light. Ones with
fresh and light Boers and foggy
squalls Saw the Miller take a Whale
Lat. 46.30 S

Sunday Nov 30th
Commenced with fresh Boers and
foggy squalls from S.W. to S.S.W. heading
to the Westward Ones with light Boers
from the S. Course W. Lat. 45.54 S
Long 81.15 W



Monday Dec 1st
Commenced with light ones and
fine weather from S. Course W. at Sea
Ones with fine weather from N.W.
Saw and took a Whale at 10 to
the at Meridian
