 Saw 2 Whales lower 3 Boats without
 success Traw with light Breeze and
 fine weather from W.N.W by the wind
 Opposite Tacks all Seal Saw Nothing
 Lat 45.45 S

Wednesday Dec 10th
 Commenced with fine weather
 Nothing in light Trawl thick and
 heady Traw with a fresh bottom
 close reefed main top sail and storm
 stay sails

Thursday Dec 11th
 Commenced with a Sale from W
 at 4 hauled and weighed to W
 Traw rough started the Traws
 Lat 45.32 S Long 91.53 W

Friday Dec 12th
 Commenced strong Breeze and squally
 from W.N.W Employed Boiling Traw with
 a strong Sale with heavy rain and
 heavy squalls from W finished Boiling
 22 bls
