Crapslow clearing up Seas with  
a strong Gale from W.N.W with  
heavy squalls of rain and hail  
Lat 46° 34' S

Sunday Dec 14<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with a strong Gale  
from W.N.W close reefed main  
top sail and stem stay sails  
Tones with a strong Gale  
Lat 45° 35' S  
Long 91° 17' W

Monday Dec 15<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with a strong Gale  
from S.W at 7 moderating Lat-  
close reefed main top sail Tones  
with moderate thick heavy weather  
from N.W stormy down  
No Obs

Tuesday Dec 16<sup>th</sup>  
Growth Bores and heavy squalls  
from the Southern Tones with  
strong Bores and heavy squalls  
Lat 45° 40' S

Wednesday Dec 17<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with a strong Gale  
from W.S.W here to close reefed  
main top sail Tones with a strong  
Gale from S.W here to W.N.W  
Lat 45° 23' S  
Long 91° 38' W

Commenced with a strong Gale from  
S.W here to close reefed main top sail  
and stem stay sails Middle Tones  
Tones with light airs and fine weather  
Nothing in sight Lat 44° 28' S  
Long 91° 45' W

Friday Dec 19<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with light airs and  
cloudy from W.N.W heading to S.W  
all sail Middle light Bores from the  
Northward down W.S.W Tones from  
E to E.S.E with thick rainy weather  
Washing ship No Obs

Saturday Dec 20<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with thick weather  
and fresh Bores from S to S.W  
and S.W Tones fine clear weather  
from W.S.W down S all sail  
Nothing in sight Lat 44° 41' S

Sunday Dec 21<sup>st</sup>  
Commenced with strong Bores  
and squalls from S.W and sail  
from W.S.W down S Tones with  
strong Bores with heavy squalls  
Lat 45° 50' S

Monday Dec 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Strong Bores and reefed back  
weather from W.S.W saw Whales  
3 Boats without success for oil with  
a fresh Gale with heavy rainy  
weather from S.W
