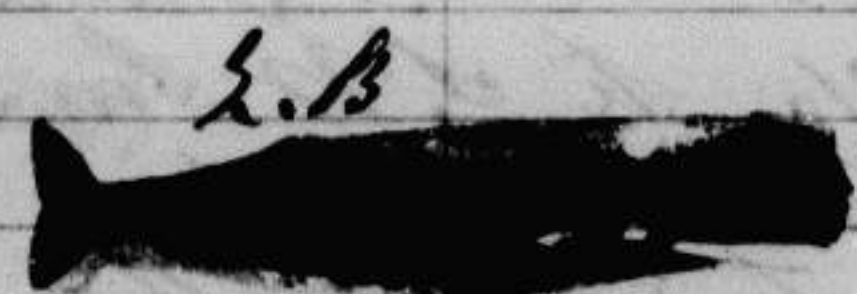


Remarks On Board Bark Lumber Op

Wednesday March 10th 1880
Commenced with strong Breeze
and clear weather from S. Opposite
Jacks double reefed 3rd. Sails. One
sail in light. Ends with fresh
Breezes and hazy weather from S
by the wind to the Eastward employed
at various jobs Lat 35-32 S
Long 74-41 W

Thursday March 11th
Commenced with fresh Breezes and
and hazy weather from S by the
wind S to S.E. all sails finished
and shifted the main 3rd. Sail
Middle Moderate and foggy from
S to S.W. employed Washing Ship
outside Lat 35-50 S

Friday March 12th
Commenced with Calms and
light airs from S.W. to W.S.W.
employed Washing Ship Outside
ends with strong Breezes and fine
weather from S. Saw sperm Whales
ends chasing 3 Boats

Saturday March 13th
Commenced with strong
Breeze got a Whale to the ship
at 3 hours B.B. Struck and drawn
S.B. got Captained got the boat
hoisted up at dark. Ends with bad
rougher time to cut the Whale parts
2 Storks green one came got the
fame here to give it to rugged
employed fitting the the boats and
clearing away the jam

New Bedford Capt Albert Lewis Master

Sunday March 14th 1880
Commenced with a fresh S. Breeze
rough weather from S. Cannot cut
Middle Moderating. Ends with a calm
cutting the Whale. Breeze away the 3rd
Boats and some more came and
Stops Lat 35-08 S

Monday March 15th
Commenced with Calm but a
heavy swell running got the Whale
all in and lashed up at 6.00
ends with light Breezes from the
North Course S.W. employed Boiling
Lat 35-46 S

Tuesday March 16th
Commenced with fresh Breezes
and thick hazy weather from N.W.
Course S.W. Boiling Middle Come
in a heavy rain had to cool down
the Works got the Head out. Ends
with a fresh S. Breeze and very fine
to N.W. No Obs

Wednesday March 17th
Commenced with thick rainy and
light variable winds cannot Boil
Middle heavy rain. Ends with thick
foggy weather light airs from W
at daylight started the Works

Thursday March 18th
Commenced with light Breeze from
W Boiling. Ends with a calm and
a heavy swell from S.W. employed
Boiling
