

Remarks On Board Bark Lancer

Saturday July 10th 1880
Commenced with light breeze
and haze from W. & W. by S. &
fresh and bent the fore & top sail
on with a fresh sail and thick
rainy weather from S.W. to S.S.W.

Sunday July 11th
Strong sail and thick rainy weather
middle moderating down to light and
ends with fresh breeze and thick
rainy weather with heavy squalls
from S.W. to S.S.W. Lat 32.09 S

Monday July 12th
Commenced with heavy rain
and a shift from N.W. to W.
ends with a strong sail from
W.S.W. have to close reefed main
top sail and storm top sails
Lat 32.07 S
Long 92.04 W

Tuesday July 13th
Commenced with a fresh sail and
heavy squalls from W.S.W. middle
with haze from S.W. ends thick and
rainy passed the Starbale
No Obs

Wednesday July 14th
Commenced thick and rainy from
S.W. at 4 cleared up 2 feet in sight
middle moderate ends calm and
reparing a main top sail

Thursday July 15th 1880
Commenced calm at 4 took a fresh
breeze from N.W. Sailed with the
Starbale ends with a fresh sail and
thick rainy weather from N.W. breeze
S.S.W. close reefed top sails

Friday July 16th
Commenced with thick haze
weather with fine rain from N.W.
have to close reefed main
top sail ends with light breeze
and fine weather Sailed with the
Jacob A. Howland and let her have
a cask of bread 3/5 gallons
Lat 32.16 S
Long 92.28 W

Saturday July 17th
Commenced light breeze from S.W.
breeze S.W. ends with light breeze
and thick haze weather from the
Eastward Steady off S.W. and S.S.W.
No Obs

Sunday July 18th
Commenced with thick rain
from S.W. breeze W.S.W. let down the
close reefed top sails to S.S.W. & S.W.
in light breeze thick and rainy
No Obs

Monday July 19th
Moderate and rainy till 4 Sailed
up a fresh sail and much sun from
S.W. to S.S.W. close reefed main top sail
ends the same thick No Obs
