Saturday Aug 21st 1880
Commenced with light seas
and cloudy weather from N
Course S.S. Seas with fresh Bows
and heavy weather from the Westward

Sunday Aug 22nd
Commenced with light Bows
with rain squalls from W.N.W.
Clear fine weather from S.W. Opposite
Jacks by the wind Nothing in Light
Lat 32.24 S
Long 82.21 W

Monday Aug 23rd
Commenced with fine weather
from S.W. heading to the Southward
Clear fine weather 2 sails in Light
Lat 32.44 S
Long 82.57 W

Tuesday Aug 24th
Fine weather Same as with the
Lucilia Bows with fine weather
and fresh Bows heading to N.W.
Lat 32.34 S

Wednesday Aug 25th
Commenced with fresh Bows
from N.W. 2 sail in Light - Clear
with a fresh Gale and thick
weather from N.W. Bows and fine
rain by the wind Shift Sail
Lat 32.14 S
Long 82.16 W

Thursday Aug 26th 1880
Commenced with a fresh Gale and
thick weather from W.N.W. have to
close up 3rd sails and storm - Stay
sails Clear fine weather Eng. tried at
various jobs Lat 32.07 S

Friday Aug 27th
Commenced light tapping and at
7 strong Bows from W. Sailed with
the Lucilia Bows with a Gale with
thick rain and heavy squalls

Saturday Aug 28th
Commenced with a strong Gale
from W.S.W. have to close up
main 3rd sail and storm Stay
sails one sail in light - Clear with
thick heavy weather and fine rain from
the Westward Lat 32.07 S
Long 82.20 W

Sunday Aug 29th
Commenced with strong Bows
and squally from W. one sail in
light - thick squally Clear fine from
W.S.W. by the wind Opposite Jacks
Lat 32.19 S
Long 82.12 W

Monday Aug 30th
Commenced with fine clear weather
from S.W. one sail in light - Clear
with light seas and fine weather
Eng. tried repairing main spar
