

Remarks On Board Bark Lancer Off

Tuesday Aug 31st 1880
Commenced with light breeze and
calms. Sailed with Lancer
Crew with fine weather from the S.E.
Cloudy No Obs

Wednesday Sept 1st
Commenced with light breeze and
cloudy from S.W. in company
with Lancer. Crew with light
breeze and cloudy from S.E.
Employed repairing main stay
sail No Obs

Thursday Sept 2nd
Commenced cloudy weather
from S.E. repairing sails
Crew with light breeze and
heavy weather shifted fore topsail
and commenced to repair the
old one Lat 32 53 S
Long 93 37 W

Friday Sept 3rd
Commenced with light breeze
and fine weather from S.E.
heating S by the wind all sail
Employed repairing fore sail
Lancer in sight. Crew fine

Saturday Sept 4th
Commenced with fresh breeze and
veering to E. Saw Whale late in forenoon
3 Boat no chance. Crew the same saw
a ship cutting to windward
Lat 33 03 S
Long 92 12 W

Sunday Sept 5th 1880
Commenced with fresh breeze and
fine weather from S.E. heading S by
the wind. Crew with fine weather from
S.E. all sail by the wind. Observed
nothing in sight Lat 34 16 S

Monday Sept 6th
Commenced with fine weather from
S.E. to N.E. by the wind. all sail
through these 24 hours the same
Lat 35 45 S
Long 91 54 W

Tuesday Sept 7th
Commenced with fine weather from
S.E. and S.E. by the wind to S.E. all sail
Bent a new main sail. Saw the Island
of Masafusa bearing N.E. by E. Crew
Calm Employed making a new sail
out of the old main sail

Wednesday Sept 8th
Commenced with calm and light
air from the southward. Clearing off
S by N for the Island at 3 light breeze
from S.W. Employed on the fore sail
Crew with fresh breeze stood in to the
land. Crew strong breeze and squally
one Boat in a fishing

Thursday Sept 9th
Strong breeze and squally at 2 Boat
came off. Wind S.E. course S by E. Middle
fine weather at daylight. Crew commenced
in light breeze S by E. Steamer first
