

Remarks On Board Bark Lancer Op

Tuesday Sept 21st 1880
Commenced with fresh breezes and
breezy weather from S to S.W. by
the wind to S.E. all sail under the
same Lat 36.24 S

Wednesday Sept 22nd
Fine weather from S to S.W. sailed
in light breeze S.E. by S. under
the same complement repairing the
Bree sail

Thursday Sept 23rd
Fine weather from S to S.W. sailed
to the Westward all sail under the
same complement shifted three sails

Friday Sept 24th
Commenced with light breeze from
the Northward steering off to South
Sea a number of sails under and
light breeze from N to N.W. by
Course S Lat 37.25 S
Long 75.13 W

Saturday Sept 25th
Commenced with light breezes
from N.W. by W. under
repairing sails under with fine
weather from the S heading to the
Eastward complement repairing
the fore sail and making a
close mizen Lat 39.55 S

Sunday Sept 26th 1880
Commenced with strong breezes from
the S heading to the Eastward till sunset
reared ship to the Westward under with fine
weather from S Course N for Mochie

Monday Sept 27th
Commenced with fine weather from
S to S.E. Course N got down off the
Mizen Mochie and huffed to off shore
to late to go in under with light breeze
and calm working in for the Mizen

Tuesday Sept 28th
Light breeze and variable worked
in to Mochie dropped anchor at
7 in 11 fathoms paid out 40 fathoms
under with strong breezes from S.E.
2 boats ashore for recruits got off
2 Boat loads of Potatoes

Wednesday Sept 29th
2 men disabled Commenced with strong breezes and
while on duty and sailed from S.E. under getting
namely off recruits repairing the sheathing
Lorenso & under calm got off all the recruits
Marten boats
Cruisers
Capturier
Lorenso

is missing

Thursday Sept 30th
Commenced with at light breezes
from S.E. by S at 1 took the anchor
and stood out by the wind S.W. under
the anchor under with fresh breezes
and fine weather from S to S.E. by
the wind complement cleaning and coaling
the the Port-Cable and painting the Mizen
mast Lat 39.04 S
