Whale 2 lowerings Tones light-ars and
Calms

Monday Oct 25th
Commenced light-ars and Calms
Tones with light Bours from N.W.
by the wind Oposite Jacks Nothing in
light

Tuesday Oct 26th
Commenced with light Bours
and fine weather from N.W. all
Sail to S.W. Saw 3 Merchantmen
Tones with fresh Bours and heavy
weather from N.W.

Wednesday Oct 27th
Commenced with fresh Bours and
heavy from N.W. and N.W. corner
S. Tones fine from N.W. by the
wind Oposite Jacks Saw one
Right Whale going quick to the
windward
