Monday Dec 27th 1880
Commenced with strong Breeze
and Hazy from W by the wind
to N.W. Saw one Sail Towed with
thick Hazy weather from N.W. by the
wind opposite tack

Tuesday Dec 28th
Commenced with thick raining
weather from N.W. Towed with
Sail Towed thick and Hazy

Wednesday Dec 29th
Commenced with light Breeze
from N.W. and near to S.W. Breeze
N. Short Sail Breeze Hazy weather
Towed Calm and light Breeze
Lat 43.12 S
Long 75.06 W

Thursday Dec 30th
Commenced with Calm Breeze
the Breeze outside at 4 light and
from the N.W. one Sail in sight
Towed with light Breeze with
Foggy Squalls

Friday Dec 31st
Commenced with strong Breeze and
squally Towed with light and
Towed a short time at 4 a
short Sail from S.W. Towed Moderate
from W. Steaming off to the land
Sail Towed a Towed in Breeze at
Meridian Towed passing from 6 to
6.30 dist 15 miles

with rain and foggy squalls from N.W. by
the wind off shore opposite Tacks
Towed Squally Towed fine from N.W. by

fine weather the Towed 10 to 20 miles off
from 6 to 8 Towed with fine weather a
few light rain and foggy squalls from
the Westward in close to the Towed saw
many Humpbacks

Monday Jan 3rd
Commenced with light Breeze and
fine weather from N.W. to N.W. Towed
the Towed and a Breeze one Towed the
Northern light Towed with light and
from N.W. Towed with the Towed
and Northern light

Tuesday Jan 4th
Fine weather and fresh Breeze from
N.W. at 7 N.W. heading W Towed in
