Thursday April 7th 1891

Commenced with fresh breezes from the S working up the Bay of Pateahua at 4 dropped anchor in 6 fathoms of water. Good fine employed unloading Sails scrubbing Bends and getting ready to paint. And fitt for home

Friday April 8th

fine weather getting ready to send out a fitt home fitting Bobstons with various jobs. Good fine weather employed paint aloft

Saturday April 9th

Commenced fine weather employed painting aloft Bends with fine weather. We dropped 3 shots from N.W. employed moving ship painting of fine from the with various jobs 5 men employed at stilla baring out. B. Rabun

Sunday April 10th

fine weather part of the sun on liberty. Good with a light North

Monday April 11th

The Steller of Hamburg commenced with a light North. has changed down. Good with a strong North at about 200 fathoms. Meridian took fine weather

Tuesday April 12th

fine weather breaking out getting to take Oil from Linda Steward. Good fine took 22 barks and commenced stowing it

Wednesday April 13th 1891

6 men employed fine weather took 18 barks of Oil 6 men employed from these barks with a strong thick rising North. failed all the time

Thursday April 14th

Commenced with a North cleared up at 8 moved to the W and to S 5 men employed Good fine employed stowing Oil

Friday April 15th

Cloudy and fresh Breezes from S.W. 6 men employed employed stowing Oil

Saturday April 16th

Strong Breezes from the S employed painting fitting Bob Stays took 9 barks of Oil

Sunday April 17th

Strong Breezes and fine weather from S half of the Bay on liberty

Monday April 18th

fine weather employed taking Oil. 7 men employed large stowing it got all the Linda Stewards Oil 5-6 barks all told

Tuesday April 19th

fine weather stowing Oil and painting 7 men employed some between Decks. Carpenter employed on the stern end sheathing

Wednesday April 20th

Commenced calm Good strong Breezes from the S took 19 barks of Oil from the custom House belonging to the Europa Shovel & Barks between Decks 7 men employed from Canacha very low. Carpenter employed barking the stern
