Employed a man for Steward 16

water casks

Fine weather 2 boatmen ashore
in Liberty

Monday April 25th
John Pearce
Booker his Liberty
Or John Lambert
Strong thick raining Norther all
these 24 hours

Tuesday April 26th
Commenced thick fog fine employed
Setting up Shooks took about 100
lbs of water
Employed 1 man
and a Steward
in a day

Wednesday April 27th
Strong breeze and fine weather from
the S employed Setting up Shooks and
stowing water drying sails

can stowed the provisions

Saturday April 30th
2 men employed
Fine weather employed stowing off
Washing Decks and Shooking some
small casks

Sunday May 1st 1891
Fine weather fresh part of the men
in Liberty

Steward employed
Fine weather employed painting

Tuesday May 3rd
Steward employed
Fine weather employed delivering things
then sold painting taking potatoes 27
sacks stowed them away

Steward employed
Cloudy weather sent out a new
fish Boom fitting the Head Sea-
