Saturday May 7<sup>th</sup>  
 Steward Emp. Vice | All these 24 hours thick and raining. clearing up and getting ready for sea

Sunday May 8<sup>th</sup>  
 Steward Emp. Vice | Fine weather from the Southward and made and 2 boat Steers on Liberty

Monday May 9<sup>th</sup>  
 Steward Emp. Vice | Strong thick raining. Nothin

Tuesday May 10<sup>th</sup>  
 Steward Emp. Vice | Thick raining. Nothin cannot do anything

Wednesday May 11<sup>th</sup>  
 Steward Emp. Vice | Most part thick. Nothin took on board about 1/2 ton of fire. Stowed it away in the oven washed off the decks clearing up head up & dishes & water getting ready for sea

Saturday May 14<sup>th</sup>  
 Thick and foggy. Sent 2 men Main Top Sail and 2 men Top Mast - Stay Sail with various jobs

Sunday May 15<sup>th</sup>  
 Joseph Allis | Heavy weather part of the hour on Liberty

Monday May 16<sup>th</sup>  
 Thick and raining from the North but fly gills and Gaff Top Sail all ready for sea except a boom

Tuesday May 17<sup>th</sup>  
 Heavy thick weather from the South Emp. Vice at various jobs taking off stores

Wednesday May 18<sup>th</sup>  
 Thick heavy weather from all parts the men left that of the Emp. Vice hauled out took off one man
