baffling winds from S to E. Oposite Jacks
ends squally from S.E. by the wind 3rd.
Sails Breeze fifth a squall

Wednesday June 8th
Commenced with Breeze and light
afternoon with rain squalls from S.E.
by the wind to S.W. all sail Breeze calm
reparing the 3rd. sail

Commenced calm at 4 light breeze from
the Westward Breeze S.E. S all sail
with strong Breeze from W to W Breeze strong
